There is a community in southern Indiana that has been positively impacted by a pregnancy center for over 30 years. Washington County has been home to CARE Pregnancy Care Center since 1988. During that time, countless families have received great love and great resources. For the past three years under the leadership of Executive Director, Donna Wesner their client growth has them bursting out of their small space. When she was hired, she reached out to me for some guidance, since she was new to pregnancy ministry. The long-time faithful board members supported Donna's efforts to update and grow the ministry. With this growth came the pains of operating in a facility that was just too small and not conducive to new education initiatives. These growing pains led us to conversations about partnership. We met with our respective boards and then Allison Adams, our Corydon Center Manager, and I met with the CARE board. After much prayer and unanimous votes by each board, it became official - we are adopting! CARE Pregnancy Center is joining the Choices Life Resource Center family and we are thrilled! One of their current board members will be joining our board and the remaining folks will continue their work of community engagement on behalf of the center. Donna and her assistant, Lora Dodson, have joined the Choices staff, bringing our team to nine.

The first order of business with our new location was to find a new location. We are in lease negotiations for two spaces adjacent to the JayC in the Gilstrap Shopping Center. An engineer is drawing up plans and the company that finished our Corydon office is on tap to do the build out. The new building will have triple the square footage of CARE's current space. It will be designed for optimum client care with much-needed parking and accessibility as a great bonus. Please follow us on Facebook and our website (www.ChoicesLRCCares.org) to watch the progress.
